→ Represents procession to sacrifice the sacred bull.

bending arms
straight down
("bull")



$\frac{L}{b}$ $\frac{R}{b}$ $\frac{L}{b}$
lift head + arms
to "W" again

→ Represents the bull, with the dancer's arms being the bull's horns.
